


Ask Me a Question Game

Directions: Print the cards on cardstock, cut up and laminate for reuse.


Whole Class:

Divide the class into equal groups. The teacher or class leader draws a card and reads the question aloud to group one. Players in group one talk amongst themselves to generate a question. Once ready, a spokesperson states the question aloud. If the question is grammatically correct one point is earned by that team. Play continues with the subsequent groups until all cards have been asked and answered (or until time is up).

 **Bonus cards** contain a directive to ask a question about a certain topic. One point is earned if a grammatically correct question is generated by the team. An additional point can be earned if the question starts with the suggested bonus word.

Small Group:

One player draws a card and reads the question aloud to another player. If the question is asked and is grammatically correct one point is earned. Play continues with the subsequent players until all cards have been asked and answered (or until time is up).

 **Bonus cards** contain a directive to ask a question about a certain topic. One point is earned if a grammatically correct question is generated by the player. An additional point can be earned if the question starts with the suggested bonus word.
